



Delegation of Powers to the Lincolnshire Show Committee.

Introduction

LBKA is a registered charity (No 500360) and its published objectives are

- To encourage, improve and advance apiculture primarily but not exclusively within Lincolnshire, to the public good
- To advance the awareness of the public in the importance of bees in the environment.

Policy

Central Council delegates powers to the Lincolnshire Show Committee to manage a bank account specifically for the purposes of organising an exhibition of beekeeping at the Lincolnshire Agricultural Society's Annual Show, which promotes LBKA and its objects and includes the Association's Annual Honey Show.

Central Council requires that:

The Committee submits an annual return of accounts to the LBKA treasurer for consolidation within LBKA's accounts. Date for submission to be agreed annually.

Organisation

The Committee will hold such meetings as necessary to produce a beekeeping event at the Lincolnshire Agricultural Society's Annual Show on behalf of LBKA.

This event will

- Present LBKA's Annual Honey Show.
- Use such means as displays and demonstrations to engage the public in such a way as to increase their awareness of the importance of bees and beekeeping to the environment.
- Promote a wide range of beekeeping activities and good husbandry.

The Committee will comprise a Secretary who is elected annually at LBKA's AGM, a Treasurer, Entries Secretary and nine additional members from LBKA's Districts.

The Secretary on election will become a Trustee of the Association.

All meetings are minuted, these minutes shall be retained by the Committee. Meeting minutes shall be available to any person requesting them.
